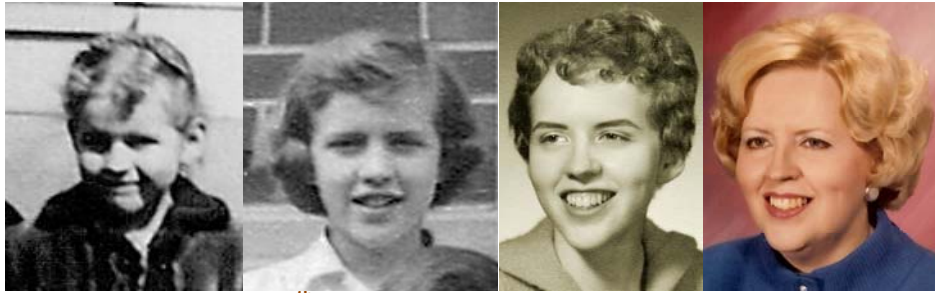

Lou Anne Lambert, 72, of Cambridge City, formerly of Irwin, PA passed away Sunday, December 7, 2014 at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis following an extended illness.
